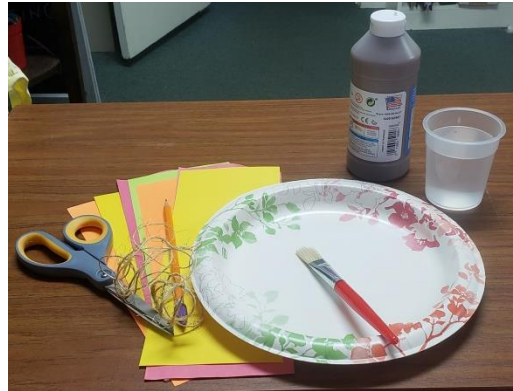


## Autumn Whirligig

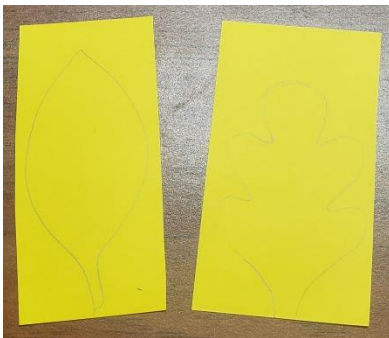
### Materials:

- Paper plate
- Brown paint
- Paintbrush
- Scissors
- Construction paper
- Pencil/drawing utensil
- Glue stick
- Twine/string



### Directions:

1. Paint your paper plate brown. (I painted the front and back.) Set aside to dry.
2. Using your drawing utensil, draw the outline of a leaf on your construction paper. You can draw multiple different leaf shapes. My leaves were a little smaller than 4 inches.



3. Using your leaf outlines, cut out multiple leaves at once in a variety of colors.



- Using your drawing utensil (I had a sharpie) decorate your leaves and write things you are thankful for on the leaves.



- Once your paper plate has dried, use your scissors and cut a spiral shape (resembles a snake).



- Using the very middle piece of the paper plate, make a small hole and attach your twine/string. I made mine a loop so I could hang it up.



- Using your glue stick, attach the leaves you have cut out around the paper plate.



- Hang up your whirligig where the wind can catch and spin it!
