Fall Photo Hikes



Join Washoe County Park Rangers this fall as we explore some of our area's most scenic trails. Amateur photographers and hiking enthusiasts alike will have the opportunity to capture their own spectacular fall photography while enjoying the trails.

Bring a sturdy pair of hiking boots, a snack, a bottle of water, and of course, your favorite camera. The hikes are medium in difficulty, and are meant to cover 3-5 miles in 2-3 hours, weather permitting. Be sure to dress in layers, and please leave pets at home.

Saturday 10/15/16 @ 12:00pm - Mt. Rose Trail

Directions: I-580 to Hwy 431 (Mount Rose Highway), follow for 16 miles to the trailhead located at the Mount Rose Summit. Join us for a leisurely hike to the Galena Creek waterfall.

Saturday 10/22/16 @ 2:00pm - Thomas Creek Trail

Directions: I-580 to Hwy 431, follow for 4 miles and turn right onto Timberline Road. The Thomas Creek Trailhead is just beyond the creek crossing past the end of the pavement. Meet at the paved parking area. This trail has beautiful fall color.

Saturday 10/29/16 @ 2:00pm - Brown's Creek Trail

Directions: I-580 to Hwy 431, follow for 5 miles to Joy Lake Road. Follow Joy Lake Road for 1.5 miles to the trailhead. Meet at the Information kiosk. Be prepared for a steep climb to the vista point before being rewarded with the views of the scenic loop trail.

Saturday 11/05/16 @ 2:00pm - Galena Creek Trail

Directions: I-580 to Hwy 431, follow for 3 miles to Callahan Ranch Rd. The Trailhead is located 1.5 miles to the south along Callahan Ranch Rd near Phillip and Annie Callahan Park. The lower Galena Creek Trail meanders along Galena Creek near Montreux Golf Club.
