CLIENT REGISTRATION

- ▶ Prospective clients may apply directly to the *Daybreak* program or they may be referred by a physician or community agency.
- ▶ An intake interview is required to determine eligibility.
- ▶ Entrance to the program is dependent upon available space and completion of the medical assessment and required forms.
- ▶ Contracts with Nevada Medicaid, Veterans Administration and Caregivers respite funds are available.

COMMUNITY BASED ADULT DAY HEALTHCARE

Daybreak Adult Day Health Care services provide coordinated programs for adults in a safe environment. Services are designed to provide social and health assistance to adults who need supervision and supportive care outside of the home. These programs also offer respite for caregivers from caregiving demands.

Services include daily living assistance, caregiver support, memory loss, medication counseling and management and delivered meals. Daybreak also provides numerous activities suited to a participant's interests and capacities.



SERVICES

This unique program offers a safe, comfortable environment and provides a wide spectrum of services under the supervision of qualified nursing staff.



RESPIRE FOR FAMILIES

Daybreak provides relief for the caregiving family, allowing them to continue with their personal activities and employment.



OVERCOMING ISOLATION

The group setting aids participants in overcoming the isolation which often occurs with illness. It also aids in maintaining physical health and emotional well-being.

CLIENT SERVICES

Daybreak is a licensed adult day health care program established in 1983 to support the needs of frail, disabled and cognitively impaired adults 18 years and above by providing social, nursing, and community support as well as serve as an alternative to institutional care.

Daybreak is the only medically based program in the region supported by full time nurses. Community Health Aides provide personal care support, social activities, and therapeutic activities including physical and cognitive exercises, as well as a noon meal and daily snacks.

Daybreak utilizes an interdisciplinary team approach with a licensed Social Worker, whom provides Case Management and conducts psycho-social assessments, needs assessments and community referrals.
