PREVIOUS ACTION & BACKGROUND

Yearly a request is made for funding for individuals from each of the three (3) primary PSAP's to attend four Dispatch Training Conferences. This conference will provide critical training on NG9-1-1 technology, and national standards and best practices for PSAP's. updates. In addition, it will address nationwide PSAP critical issues.

FISCAL IMPACT

The Enhanced 911 Fund is a special revenue fund which receives revenue pursuant to NRS 244A.7643 in the form of telephone surcharges collected to support the emergency reporting system. Budget authority exists within the E911 Fund to the travel and training to 4 public safety training conferences.


