Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Budget [For Possible Action] Presentation, discussion, and possible action to recommend that the FY24-25 Budget for Accela Automation, Mobile and Citizen Access Annual Subscription fees, licenses, Enhanced Reporting Database (Washoe County, Washoe County Assessor's Office, Health District, City of Sparks, City of Reno), and Gray Quarter (Washoe County, Health District) be apportioned per participating agency as noted below.  - a.) Douglas County not to exceed amount of \$94,000;
 - b.) Health District not to exceed the amount of \$142,000;
 - c.) City of Reno not to exceed amount of \$340,000;
 - d.) City of Sparks not to exceed amount of \$150,000; and
 - e.) Washoe County not to exceed the amount of \$214,000.
- 6. Health Workflow Subprocess Regional Alignment [Non-Action Item] A review, update and possible discussion on the progress to streamline and simplify Health Workflow Subprocess for Plan Review for Building Permits (Washoe County Technology Services, Northern Nevada Public Health). Currently Health inspectors review and approve plans for building permits for City of Reno, City of Sparks and Washoe County. The health subprocess for each agency is vastly different and causes confusion and delays for Health inspectors. Aligning the workflows for allow for more consistency and efficiency to health plan reviews. The health workflow subprocess is currently in testing under the Washoe Agency. - 7. Accela ACA (Accela Citizen Access) Improvements [Non-Action Item] A review, update and possible discussion of Accela Citizen Access (ACA) improvements and possible impacts to ACA wrapper. Accela is planning on a two year roadmap for ACA improvements for easier application submittal for citizens as well as preventing any future errors or disruptions during product updates. Possible Changes to Agenda and Timing: The Oversight Group may consider items on this agenda out of order, may combine two or more items for consideration, may remove an item from the agenda, or may delay discussion of an item on the agenda at any time. Items scheduled to be heard at a specific time will be heard no earlier than the stated time but may be heard later.

Public Comment: Public comments are welcomed during the Public Comment periods at the beginning and end of the meeting for all matters, whether listed on the agenda or not. Additionally, public comment specific to the action item being considered will be heard during individual action items on the agenda. Public comments are limited to three (3) minutes per person per comment period. Persons may not allocate unused time to other speakers. Members of the public may submit public comment by logging into the Teams Meeting at the above link and utilizing the "Raise Hand" feature during any public comment period. NOTE: This option will require a computer with audio and video capabilities. Members of the public who are attending the meeting by telephone may submit public comment by pressing *5 to "Raise Hand" and *6 to mute/unmute. Additionally, persons are invited to submit comments in writing by emailing Sara DeLozier at sdelozier@washoecounty.gov. Washoe County will make reasonable efforts to send all email comments received by 4:00 p.m. on December 18, 2023, to the Oversight Group members prior to the meeting.

Responses to Public Comments: The Oversight Group can deliberate or take action only if a matter has been listed on an agenda properly posted prior to the meeting. The Open Meeting Law does not expressly prohibit responses to public comments by the Oversight Group. However, responses from members to unlisted public comment topics could become deliberation on a matter without notice to the public. To avoid this situation and to ensure the public has notice of all matters the Oversight Group will consider, members may choose not to respond to public comments, except to correct factual inaccuracies, ask for Washoe County staff action, or to ask that a matter be listed on a future Oversight Group meeting agenda.

Forum Restrictions and Orderly Conduct of Business: The presiding officer may order the removal

of any person whose statement or other conduct disrupts the orderly, efficient, or safe conduct of the meeting. Warnings against disruptive comments or behavior may or may not be given prior to removal. The viewpoint of a speaker will not be restricted, but reasonable restrictions may be imposed upon the time, place, and manner of speech. Irrelevant and unduly repetitious statements and personal attacks which antagonize or incite others are examples of speech that may be reasonably limited. Other examples of disruptive conduct include, without limitation, yelling, stamping of feet, whistles, applause, heckling, name calling, use of profanity, threatening use of physical force, or any other acts intended to impede the meeting or infringe on the rights of the Oversight Group, staff, or meeting participants.
