Be a Poll Worker

It's as easy as 1-2-3



The Washoe County Registrar of Voters Office continually recruits volunteers for Election Day.

Volunteering at the polls is a fun opportunity to participate in the election process and earn a few extra dollars. Our democracy depends on the support of individuals like you working the polls on Election Day.

Our statewide Primary and General elections are held in June and November of even-numbered years, and when necessary, Special Elections.

We are looking for people who:

- Enjoy working with others
- Are willing to commit to a long and rewarding day at the polls
- Take pride in serving the citizens of Washoe County

Qualifications:

- You must be a **registered voter** and a **resident of Washoe County**;
- You must be at least 18 years old or be a student who has attained the age of 16 years (please call the office for further details);
- Be physically able to assemble equipment;
- Be willing to attend at least the required **2 hour training class** held before each election;
- Have good hearing and eyesight;
- **NOT** be a candidate for nomination or election;
- **NOT** be a relative of a candidate for nomination or election.



Responsibilities:

- ✓ Setting up the polling place
- ✓ Checking voters in and explaining to them how to operate the Edge machine in order to cast their ballot.
- ✓ At the end of Election Day, you and your fellow poll workers will restore the polling place to its original condition and return the elections supplies to County Elections Office.
- ✓ You must be able to work the whole day which can be up to 14 hours long or longer
